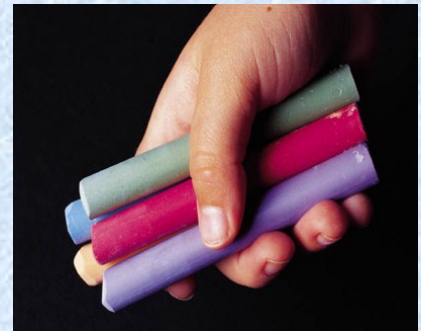


2014 RGV Water Conservation Poster Contest
