The “8 codes” are for use with local-credit courses, including courses at the designated grade level, and are available to students receiving general education **and/or** special education services.

Local credit

No substitutions are allowed for required high school courses or credits for students receiving special education services who entered grade 9 beginning with the 2011-2012 school year.

At all grade levels, courses in the required curriculum and/or required for graduation that have been modified in content as a result of an ARD committee decision should be coded using the standard code for the subject area at the designated grade level.
