The Turnaround Leaders' Academy (TLA) is a year-long, three-day academy for new and experienced Principals and Assistant Principals. The TLA develops leader's **turnaround competencies**. Through learning strategies and protocols for leading the school turnaround process, participants develop the Turnaround Leader Competencies for **Monitoring & Directive-ness, Planning Ahead, Analytical/Conceptual Thinking, Team Leadership** and **Developing Others**. Acquisition of these skills helps prepare the next generation of principals and district leaders to improve student outcomes.

Topics:

- Leading Teams-Strategies and protocols for facilitating effective, results-oriented meetings
- Coaching Teachers-How to have difficult post-visit conversations, intentional scheduled classroom visits, and create a culture of data literacy
- Student Management-Discipline management, "referable vs. non-referable" infractions, PBIS, duty schedules, and active supervision
- Planning Assessments-Benchmark and state test scheduling, and
- State and Federal Accountability Systems-STAAR, DVM, PBMAS, A-F
