Here is the Region One ESC training calendar for Maintenance and Operations trainings that TASB Facility Services is providing this year.

These trainings are being offered at NO COST to the districts of Region One.

- December 6th – Asbestos Designated Person Training
- December 7th – Integrated Pest Management Coordinator
- December 8th – Environmental/Facilities Regulatory Compliance

All classes will start promptly at 8am.

Asbestos Designated Person Training – Dec 6

Subject: This class addresses areas defined in the AHERA regulations for those responsible for the school's asbestos program.

Topics covered include asbestos detection, identification, and assessment; health effect associated with asbestos exposure; control options; relevant federal and state regulations; and management plan components.

This class satisfies the training requirements put forth in AHERA for Asbestos Designated Person training.

Although there are no refresher requirements, it is a good idea to come back to this class every few years to keep relevant asbestos issues and requirements fresh on you mind.

Integrated Pest Management Coordinator Training – Dec 7

Subject: This course meets the requirements outlined by the Texas Structural Pest Control Services department within the TDA for training a school district's Integrated Pest Management (IPM) coordinator.

Topics include regulatory requirements, administration of IPM in school pest control programs, principles of IPM, and pesticide safety practices.

This class satisfies the requirements for both the initial IPM Coordinator training and **provides all 6 continuing education units** as required by the regulations to be completed every three years.

Environmental/Facilities Regulatory Compliance – Dec 8

Subject: This class offers an in-depth look at all environmental and facility regulations that effect schools, and how to maintain compliance with these regulations.

Topics include: above ground storage tanks, tier II reporting, backflow prevention testing, playground safety, boilers, gas lines, swimming pools, and many more.

This class will present a topic, discuss the relevant regulations, and then layout what schools are required to do in order to maintain compliance.
