HB 3906 Beyond Assessment *Cross-curricular Educator Camp*

House Bill (HB) 3906 passed by the 86th Texas Legislature creates transformative changes to the STAAR assessment program. The transition includes online assessments, new item types, additional writing in reading language arts, and cross-curricular passages. Learn how to successfully plan and prepare for the significant changes brought about by HB 3906.

This session is designed for 5th grade classroom teachers and instructional coaches. Participants will engage in a general STAAR Redesign session and four breakout sessions. Participants will experience core content lessons designed to accelerate learning for 4th students going into 5th grade and are currently served by migrant, special education, or bilingual programs.
