THE BRAILLE CHALLENGE IS THE ONLY NATIONAL READING AND WRITING CONTEST IN BRAILLE FOR STUDENTS WHO ARE BLIND AND VISUALLY IMPAIRED. REGIONAL CONTESTS ARE OPEN TO STUDENTS OF ALL ABILITIES, GIVING EVEN EMERGING BRAILLE READERS A CHANCE TO REACH A PERSONAL BEST SCORE.

OUR LOW VISION CHALLENGE IS A COMPETITION WHERE STUDENTS OF ALL AGES WILL HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO WORK TOGETHER TO FIND ITEMS AND CLUES THAT WILL HELP THEM COMPLETE A COOKING LESSON AS A TEAM. STUDENTS WILL UTILIZE THEIR ECC SKILLS OF ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY, COMPENSATORY, SELF-DETERMINATION, INDEPENDENT LIVING, SOCIAL SKILLS, AND O&M SKILLS TO HELP THEM COMPLETE THEIR TASKS.
