The campus is closed OR has been operating with reduced attendance or hours for at least five (5) consecutive days due to the COVID-19 emergency in the current school year.
This could be a single student at the school with five consecutive days of COVID-19-related absences or virtual attendance.

(Must meet each of these)

1
The child is enrolled in an NSLP-eligible Texas campus. (This includes schools that are operating the SSO during the school year.)

2
The student has **COVID-19 related** absences, eligible virtual attendance, or school closures during the 2021-2022 school year.

3
Student is directly certified or certified by NSLP household application for free or reduced meals (**Eco Dis PEIMS codes 01 or 02**).
For CEP and P2 Schools, these students automatically meet #3 requirement.

It is important to note that P-EBT benefits require individual income eligibility unless a child attends a CEP or P2 school. Income eligibility must be determined through direct certification or through certification of the NSLP household meal application.

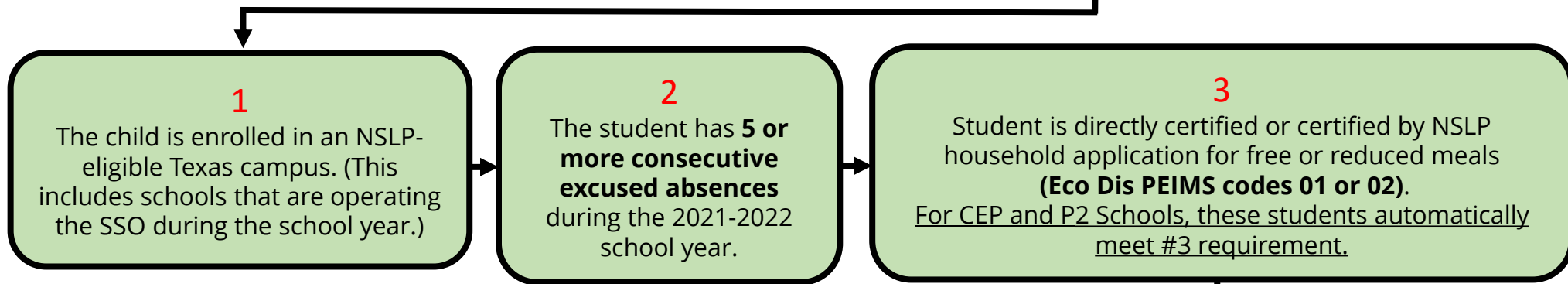
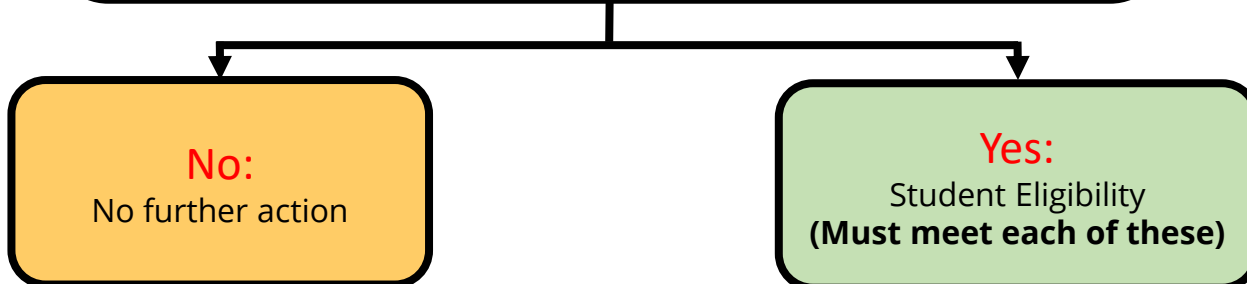

Campus Eligibility:
If COVID-19-related absences are not tracked by the campus, the campus becomes eligible the first occurrence a student with 5 or more consecutive excused absences.
