

1. Language Eligibility. Place a check (✓) beside the documentation attached.

- Home language survey (HLS) indicates the child hears/speaks a language other than English at home.
- Assessment with the Oral Language Proficiency Test.
 - All children whose Home Language Survey reports that SPANISH is the other language will be tested in Spanish and English with the OLPT. A score of 1, 2, or 3 indicates eligibility as LEP and the child is placed in the bilingual PK program.
 - All children whose HLS reports a language other than Spanish is tested with the oral English assessment (OLPT). A score of 1, 2, or 3 indicates eligibility as LEP and the child is placed in the ESL PK program.
- Parent must sign Notification of Enrollment in Bilingual / ESL program.

2. Income Eligibility. Place a check (✓) beside the form of documentation attached.

Documentation of income for eligibility purposes must be provided. The following is a list of acceptable income documentation.

- **Households must report current income on the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) PEIMS Income Survey**
 - paycheck stub showing income and how often it is received
 - social security/pension/retirement documentation with income; please specify
 - unemployment compensation/disability/worker's compensation documentation
 - TANF or other welfare payments (food stamps)
 - child support/alimony payments
 - letter explaining that family receives no income, provision of specific information about how food, clothing and housing for the family is obtained; and a date when the family expects to begin receiving income
 - military income/benefits received in cash
 - for a foster child, funds provided by the welfare agency and identified by category for the child's personal use as well as any funds received from his family
 - private employer notarized statement of income

3. Homeless Eligibility. Place a check (✓) beside the documented reason submitted for eligibility.

- Child lacks a fixed, regular, and adequate residence.
- Primary nighttime residence is a supervised public or private shelter designed to provide temporary living accommodations, or an institution that provides temporary residence for individuals intended to be institutionalized.
- Primary nighttime residence is a public or private place not designed for, or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings.

4. Military Eligibility. Place a check (✓) beside the form of documentation attached.

Military Eligibility will be determined as follows:

- Department of Defense identification, such as a DoD photo identification card.
- "Statement of service" from the Installation Adjutant General/Director of Human Resources.
- An official letter from a commander stating that he or she is on active duty or mobilized.
- Copy of the death certificate or Department of Defense form that indicates that the reason for the separation from service was because of death.
- Memorandum signed by the Casualty Office stating the service member was killed in action or died while serving.
- Copy of the Purple Heart citation, a copy of the Line of Duty Determination or a letter from a commander.
- Copy of the Line of Duty Determination documentation for children of service members or mobilized reservists/guardsmen who were injured while serving on active duty.
- Copy of appropriate documentation for children of service members who are "Missing in Action."

5. Is the child of a person eligible for the Star of Texas Award as: a. a peace officer under Section 3106.002, Government Code; b. a firefighter under section 3106.003, Government Code; or c. an emergency medical first responder under Section 3106.004, Government Code.
