PEIMS

- The 2022-2023 PEIMS Fall Resubmission is due on **Thursday, January 19, 2023.**
- The 2022-2023 PEIMS Mid-Year First Submission is due on **Thursday, January 26, 2023.**
- PDM1-321-001 Presumed Underreported Students List is now available for Fall First Submission.

- The following **new known issues** will be updated in the software release on **Friday, January 27, 2023**.
 - **PDM2-100-004** Actual Financial Revenues by Fund & Object
 - Fund code 420 budget amounts are being included in column Fund 4xx. Column Fund 4xx should exclude fund code 420.
 - **PDM2-102-003** Statement of Revenues, Expenditures, & Changes in Fund Balances
 - No data is displayed for fund code 283 (Supplemental ESSER) when selected to print on report.

Class Roster



- The Class Roster Winter Submission is due on **Thursday, March 30, 2023.**
 - The submission is ready for users to promote data on Monday, January 30, 2023.
 - The snapshot date is on Friday, February 24, 2023.

Class Roster

- The following **reports** will be updated in the software release on **Friday, January 27, 2023**.
 - **CLS2-100-004** Teacher Class Summary:
 - Report is taking an excessive amount of time to process.
 - **CLS2-100-005** Staff Roster:
 - Teachers that have the same exact name are being suppressed from displaying on the report.

Class Roster

- The following **business validation rules** will be updated in the software release on **Friday, January 27, 2023**:
 - **Class Roster Winter validation rules**
 - **30040-0022**
 - The rule is configured as a Fatal error, where the Texas Education Data Standards (TEDS) specifies that it should be a Special Warning.
 - When the DATE-OF-BIRTH value is empty (as it is not required), an Oracle exception is being triggered that causes the validation to fail for that subcategory.
 - **30310-0003**
 - Update rule text from "last three characters are CAMPUS-ID" to "last three characters of CAMPUS-ID".

- The ECDS Kindergarten Submission is due on **Thursday, January 26, 2023.**
 - Current Status Counts:
 - Completed: **414**
 - Promoted: **30**
 - Validated: **231**
 - Validated without Assessments: **36**

- **ECDS KG Spanish Assessments:**
 - LEAs that do not have a '001' campus:
 - In order to accommodate loading ECDS KG Spanish assessment XML files into the ODS, the file naming structure for all Spanish Assessments has been updated to '999' for campus:
 - Ex: 701603_999_202312221418_InterchangheAssessmentMetadata.xml
 - Ex: 701603_999_202312221418_InterchangheAssessmentMetadata.xml

ECDS

- The following **report application** screen will be updated in the software release on **Friday, January 27, 2023**:
 - **ECDO-000-007** Early Childhood PK Completion:
 - Add the parameter label of “Student Criteria Selection” to select data from the BOY or EOY assessments or to select data for students who have not taken any assessments.
 - Add the following Student Criteria Selection parameter values:
 - All PK Students (with or w/o Assessments)
 - PK Students w/ BOY Assessments
 - PK Students w/ EOY Assessments
 - PK Students w/ BOY and EOY Assessments
 - PK Students w/ No BOY or EOY Assessments

ECDS

- The following **report** will be updated in the software release on **Friday, January 27, 2023:**
 - **ECDO-000-009** Early Childhood Public PK Missing Assessment Data:
 - The Campus level report displays the term 'Prepared' for all data being promoted for the ECDS PK submission. The report will be changed to display the status as 'Promoted' to match the terminology on the LEA level report.

SPPI-14

- The SPPI-14 Submission is due on **Thursday, February 16, 2023.**
- **REMINDER:** Submissions with a status of ‘COMPLETION IN PROGRESS’ are not considered complete. LEAs with a submission in this status must return to the SPPI-14 Collection in Core and confirm the acknowledgment statement on the Prepare/Finalize Submission tab.
 - ESCs can check the status of their LEA’s submissions on the ‘**Prepare/Finalize Page: LEA Overview**’ screen or by running the **SPP0-000-002** report.

- The following rules and logic will be updated in the software release on **Friday, January 27, 2023**:
 - The rules below will be upgraded from a special warning to a **fatal**:
 - 41163-0082
 - 41163-0085 through 41163-0092.
 - Rule **41163-0082** will be updated to not fire when the INSTRUCTIONAL-TRACK-INDICATOR-CODE is not reported for the child.
 - The SPPI-11 initial evaluation and eligibility determination compliances will be accurately determined for students reported with a CAMPUS-ID-OF-EVALUATION that did not have calendar data reported in the prior year PEIMS Summer Submission.

Child Find

- The following **reports** will be updated in the software release on **Friday, January 27, 2023**:
 - **CHF0-100-002 SPPI-12 Student Compliance Report**
 - Update to include a column showing the calculated number of days between the ECI EFFECTIVE-DATE and the child's 3rd birthday.
 - Reminder: Children with a count of less than 90 days will have their compliance determined through the SPPI-11 timeframe.
 - **CHF0-100-002 SPPI-12 Student Compliance Report**
 - Update to include a **CSV** version of the report.
 - **CHF0-100-005 SPPI-11 Calculations Report**
 - New report will be added to display all of the **intermediate calculations** performed by the Core application that go into determining the SPPI-11 compliance.
 - Users can utilize for **troubleshooting** student non-compliance issues and will only be available in **CSV** format.

Child Find

- Guidance for the StudentChildFindAssociationExtension was updated in the Texas Education Data Standards version 2023.2.1.

DR2

STUDENT-ABSENCES-WITHIN-TIMEFRAME (E1711) indicates the number of student absences, if any, beginning the first instructional day following the date on which the Local Education Agency (LEA) received written parental consent for the full individual and initial evaluation (FIE) report.

STUDENT-ABSENCES-WITHIN-TIMEFRAME is used in the Child Find collection for determining if the timeframe for evaluation must be extended by the number of absences (three or more absences) between PARENTAL-CONSENT-DATE (E1714) and the INITIAL-EVALUATION-DATE (E1715).

School day does not include a day that falls after the last instructional day of the spring term and before the first instructional day of the subsequent fall term. A student is considered absent for the school day if the student is not in attendance at the official attendance taking time or at the alternate attendance taking time set for that student.

TEDS - ASVAB Indicator Code



- In the CTE newsletter on January 5, 2023, information about reporting the ASVAB exam was provided. There is **no change** to ASVAB reporting during the PEIMS Fall Resubmission.

Through PEIMS Fall Resubmission due on
January 19, 2023**

Each year, LEAs are required to report through the PEIMS Fall Submission the date(s) the ASVAB, or alternate test, was or will be offered to students. PEIMS submission deadlines are in the [TSDS Web-Enabled Data Standards](#) (TWEDS). Contact your PEIMS coordinator to ensure your school district or open enrollment charter school is reporting your ASVAB test data accurately.
