PEIMS



- PEIMS 2021-2022 Extended Year resubmission is due **Thursday, September 15, 2022.**
- The 2022-2023 PEIMS Fall submission will be ready for users to promote on **Monday, September 12, 2022.**

PEIMS: Known Issue for 2021-2022 Extended Year



- **Rule 43415-0027**

For the campus reported in CAMPUS-ID-OF-ENROLLMENT, the grade range registered with the TEA must include at least one of grades “09-12”.

- **Known Issue:**

This rule is firing for campuses that contain grades 6-8 and should be applicable to grades 6-12.

This rule has been updated for 2022-2023 in the TEDS post addendum (2023.2.1).

If an LEA receives this fatal rule validation when the grade level is 06-08, please advise them to enter a TIMS ticket so TEA can assist with their Extended Year resubmission.



Charter School Waitlist

- The Charter School Waitlist (CSW) data submission will open for LEAs to promote data on **September 12, 2022**:
 - Snapshot date for CSW: **September 30, 2022**.
 - Ready for users to complete: **September 30, 2022**.
 - Submission due date for LEAs: **October 28, 2022**.
- Students on the waitlist who do not currently have a Unique ID (UID) should be assigned a UID. Every effort should be made to determine if the student has an existing UID.
- If the Ethnicity and Ethnicity/Race codes are not known for a waitlist student, the Charter campus personnel will need to use the '**TEA Use Only**' value field in the UID system when obtaining a UID.

SPPI-14: Known Issue

KNOWN ISSUE:

- The SPPI-14 data collection is currently promoting StudentLeaverExtension data from **PEIMS Fall3** (Working Collection) in the ODS, if it has been loaded, to the SPPI-14 data mart.
 - SPPI-14 should only be using ODS data from the **PEIMS Fall1** or **Fall2** collections.
 - This is scheduled to be resolved in the software release on **November 4, 2022**.

Child Find

- The 2022-2023 Child Find data collection will open for LEAs to promote data on **September 12, 2022**.
- The following items are scheduled for the software release on **September 9, 2022**:
 - Add new data element **E1731 ELIGIBILITY-DETERMINATION-DELAY-REASON**
 - The **CHF0-100-001** and **CHF0-100-002** reports are scheduled to be updated with this data element in the software release on **November 4, 2022**.

- Report **CHF0-100-004** SPPI-12 Aggregate Report was updated in the **September 2, 2022**, software release:
 - The count for row (a) "***Children Served in Part C and Referred to Part B for Part B Eligibility Determination***" has been updated to only include students reported with a value for data element **E1632 EFFECTIVE-DATE**.
 - Previously, the count for row (a) only included students reported with a value for E1712 ECI-NOTIFICATION-DATE.
 - The need for this change was discovered during the Child Find clarifications period and was requested by the program area to assist LEAs in identifying their SPPI-12 non-compliance students.

September 9, 2022 Deployment:

- **Add new rules to align with TEDS 2023.1.0.**
 - **40100-0225** – DATE-OF-BIRTH must not be greater than the date the data was promoted.
 - **41163-0089** – If SPPI-11 Eligibility Determination Compliance (calculated value) is "Y", then ELIGIBILITY-DELAY-REASON should not be reported.
 - **41163-0090** – If SPPI-11 Eligibility Determination Compliance (calculated value) is "N", then ELIGIBILITY-DELAY-REASON should be reported.
 - **41163-0091** – If SPPI-12 Eligibility Determination Compliance (calculated value) is "Y", then ELIGIBILITY-DELAY-REASON should be either not reported, "05", or "07".
 - **41163-0092** – If SPPI-12 Eligibility Determination Compliance (calculated value) is "N", then ELIGIBILITY-DELAY-REASON should be reported and should not be "05" or "07".
- **Revise rules to align with TEDS 2023.1.0.**
 - **41163-0083** – Added 'or ELIGIBILITY-DELAY-REASON'
 - **41163-0084** – Added 'and ELIGIBILITY-DELAY-REASON must not be "08"'
 - **41163-0087** – Added 'Initial Evaluation'
 - **41163-0088** – Added 'Initial Evaluation'

SELA

- The 2022-2023 SELA data collection will open for LEAs to promote data on **September 12, 2022**.
- The following items are scheduled to be deployed in the software release on **September 9, 2022**:
 - The value for disability code '06' on the DC142 DISABILITY code table will be updated from 'Hearing/Auditory Impairment (Auditory Impairment)' to '**Deaf And Hard Of Hearing**'.
 - Report SEL0-100-001 will be updated to display a short description of '**DHH**' for any student reported with disability 06 – Deaf And Hard Of Hearing.
 - Revised rule **40100-0204** – Replaced 'Hearing/Auditory Impairment (Auditory Impairment)' with 'Deaf And Hard Of Hearing'

Summer P-EBT

- September 29, 2022: Training Opportunity for ESCs
 - Webinar time to be announced.

- Summer P-EBT Dates: July 1, 2022 - August 29, 2022

- As it is now the upload period will likely be mid to late October with data verifications happening mid-November.

Summer P-EBT

- The expectation, at this time, is that two uploads will be required of LEAs for their NSLP-campususes:
 - First Upload: local education agencies (LEAs) will upload 2021-2022 students that were economically disadvantaged ('01' or '02') or they were identified as homeless, foster care or migrant.
 - Second Upload: LEAs will upload students that became newly eligible for free or reduced-price meals between July 1-August 29, 2022.

Note: The student must also have been enrolled in an NSLP-campus within the last month of the 2021-2022 school year to be eligible for P-EBT. TEA will provide this data to the Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC).

 - Addresses with numbers only:
 - Example: 1002 1002
 - Out of country addresses:
 - Example: Mexico
 - Out of state addresses:
 - Example: New Mexico
 - Addresses with line one information duplicated into line two:
 - Example: 122 TEA Street/122 TEA Street/ Austin TX

TEDS: C022 Table Updates

- The State Board of Education (SBOE) adopted new Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) in 2020 for physical education and health education that will be implemented beginning with the 2022-2023 school year.
- New service IDs were created for two new high school PE courses: **Lifetime Fitness and Wellness Pursuits** (PES00051) and **Skill-Based Lifetime Activities** (PES00056).
- Existing course (PES00053) name was changed to **Lifetime Recreating and Outdoor Pursuits**.
- The SBOE eliminated ranges of credit for courses as part of the review and revision process. All high school PE courses are now one-credit courses.

TEDS: 2022-2023 POST ADDENDUM PUBLICATION



- On **August 19, 2022**, the **2022-2023 TEDS Post-Addendum** publication for both the current and the ODS 3.x versions were released. The post-addendum included:
 - Additional codes added to:
 - INDUSTRY-CERTIFICATION-LICENSURE-CODE (C214)
 - VENDOR-CODE (C226)
