### Region One School Districts Rank among Best in Texas for Feeding Low-income Students

Child Nutrition Programs in the Region One area earned honors from Children at Risk, a nonprofit organization that uses research and data to learn more about Texas children and their families.

The 2021 Kroger Food Rankings evaluate how school districts across the state provide meals to low-income area school children by focusing on meal participation rates and after-school meal programs in each school district. The organization released their annual school food rankings for top Texas school districts and Region One school districts were well represented.
